<b>Describe Kay El Bar</b>	Authentic, intimate, friendly – a genuine dude ranch experience
<b>Ranch history</b>	Kay El Bar has been a guest ranch since 1926 and is listed on the Arizona and National Historic Registers.
<b>Ranch location</b>	Kay El Bar is in the Sonoran Desert, in the shadow of the Hassayampa River Canyon Wilderness. Nearby Hassayampa Hill offers desert vistas and unforgettable sunsets.
<b>Ranch altitude</b>	2130'
<b>Ranch Acres</b>	100 acres
<b>Acres available for riding</b>	More than 2,000 acres of state and federal land administered by the Bureau of Land Management.
<b>Guest season</b>	Kay El Bar is a winter ranch, open November to May.
<b>Weather</b>	Weather during the ranch season is ideal for riding, in the 60s and 70s during the day. See weather link on Wickenburg page of website.
<b>Guest capacity</b>	28
<b>Lodging</b>	Each room has a western motif and modern private bathrooms. Eight rooms in the Lodge; one 3-room family house; one 4-person family casita; one 2-person casita. See Room Configurations chart on website.
<b>Meals</b>	Home cooking served family style in our cozy dining room or cookout style by cowboy campfire; fresh-baked cookies available throughout the day.
<b>All-inclusive price</b>	American Plan –daily rate includes 3 meals, lodging, horseback riding, and use of ranch facilities. Reduced rates for children. See Rates page on website.
<b>Deposit and Cancellation Policy</b>	50% deposit at time of reservation; partial refund based on time to arrival date. See Rates page on website.
<b>Check-in and Check-out</b>	Check-in at 2 p.m. or later; check-out by 10 a.m.; guests welcome to enjoy a morning ride and lunch after check out
<b>Riding equipment</b>	The ranch provides loaner helmets, hats, boots and gifted water bottles; see What to Bring chart on website.
<b>Dress</b>	Casual, practical, with an emphasis on Western wear. Jeans and long sleeve shirts recommended for most activities. See What to Bring chart on website.
<b>Alcohol Policy</b>	Due to state law, no outside alcohol is permitted on property. The ranch offers a private licensed bar with an excellent selection of alcoholic beverages for purchase.



<b>Laundry facilities</b>	Available on the premises for guest use for a fee. Supplies provided.
<b>WiFi</b>	Free.
<b>Ranch activities</b>	Horseback Riding; hiking; stargazing; bird watching; heated swimming pool & hot tub; evening campfires; games and puzzles available in the living room; Team Penning. See Activities pages of website.
<b>Riding</b>	Twice daily except Sundays and holidays morning-only. Sunday has a long morning ride with cowboy cookout brunch. All-day rides provided upon request with sack lunch provided. See Riding page of website.
<b>Hiking</b>	The ranch offers a scenic hiking trail with panoramic views.
<b>Birding</b>	Abundant bird species identified on the ranch by the Audubon Society.
<b>Nearby activities</b>	Golf and tennis are available a short drive from the ranch; the office can provide a list.
<b>Historic Wickenburg</b>	The nearby historic town of Wickenburg features the Desert Caballeros Museum, Del E. Webb Center for the Performing Arts, and a variety of quaint shops and galleries. See Wickenburg page of website.
<b>Pets</b>	No pets allowed on the ranch. The office can provide a list of local kennels.
<b>Smoking</b>	Smoking is permitted on the patio and in outdoor areas. Please respect our no smoking policy in the guest rooms and inside all ranch buildings.
<b>Nearest international airport</b>	Phoenix (AZ) Sky Harbor International, 72 miles from the ranch.
<b>Transportation from airport</b>	Guests are responsible for their own transportation to and from the ranch. Wickenburg-based Airport Express shuttle info available. Call for details.
